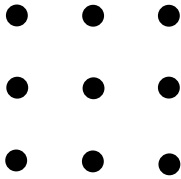






BRAIN TEASERS

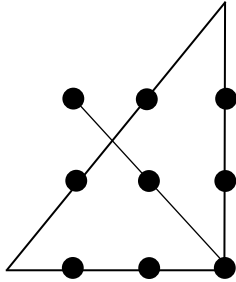
1. What is in seasons, seconds, centuries and minutes, but not in decades, years or days?
