


Walk Through the Heart **Crossword Puzzle**

ACROSS CLUES:

- 2. A gas produced as a waste product in the body
- 3. Special substances of food that are necessary for your good health.
- 5. Blood vessels that return blood to the Heart
- 7. Hollow spaces in the heart where blood flows.
- 10. "Doors" in the heart which keep the blood flowing in the right direction.
- 13. A fluid that circulates oxygen and nutrients in the body and helps remove carbon dioxide.
